



A gift to Redwood Day in your will or revocable living trust enables you to support our mission and make a difference in the lives of future generations. A bequest:

- Is easy to arrange.
- Will not alter your current lifestyle in any way.
- Can be easily modified to address your changing needs.

The amount left to the School (or any charity) can be expressed as a dollar amount or as a percentage of the assets to be given. Many people put aside a percentage -- which could be 10% or 20% -- for their favorite causes, while still leaving a large majority of their assets to family and friends. Others choose to make a charitable gift of whatever balance remains after gifts are made to your family and friends.

To make a gift to Redwood Day from your estate, you must sign a new will or living trust instrument, add a codicil to your present will, or make an amendment to your present trust instrument.

A residual bequest comes to us after your estate expenses and specific bequests are paid:

Specific Gifts:

Naming Redwood Day School as a beneficiary of a specific amount from your estate is easy:
